Saranac Lake Free Library 2024 Annual Association Report

HIGHLIGHTS

2024 was a year of growth, innovation, and deeper community connections at the Saranac Lake Free Library. Among our major accomplishments, we applied for and were awarded a \$127,212 New York State Aid for Library Construction grant that supported projects such as LED lighting installations, energy-efficient heating and cooling solutions to make the library more comfortable, and advanced AV upgrades to the Cantwell Room. These improvements enhanced both the functionality and sustainability of our spaces. On the technology front, we expanded digital services, leading to significant growth in user engagement for the apps Libby and Hoopla, which together accounted for 30% of our total yearly circulation. The introduction of new programs, like Tuesday Evening Yoga, brought in young professionals, while events like the High Peaks Harvest Festival and the Library Crawl fostered greater community participation. We also introduced new services, including a Seed Swap/Sharing Library, family skate rental passes, and an improved room reservation system on our website. We hosted our first Ukrainian art exhibit and gala fundraiser, raising funds for civilian relief efforts in Ukraine and showcasing global perspectives.

TRENDS


Library usage has continued to rise as our programs and services evolve to meet community needs. The Cantwell Room remained a popular space for events, with peak monthly attendance surpassing 1,900. Library programs and events attracted diverse audiences. External community groups reserved the Cantwell Room nearly 200 times for meetings and events, demonstrating the library's role as a cultural and social hub. Although digital circulation seemed to have plateaued a few years ago, the recent spike shows that more people are engaging with the library remotely. Hoopla, in particular, has been gaining strong traction with over 1,500 checkouts since its launch.

LOOKING AHEAD

As we look forward to 2025, we are excited to build on last year's momentum. We are preparing for the next grant cycle to support additional building upgrades. Expanded programming will remain a key focus. In fact, 2025 marks the inaugural year of our NYSCA grant funded Writer-in-Residency program. This program will provide some new programming opportunities for the library while supporting the Arts in our community. Additionally, we aim to support the popular digital services like Hoopla while managing costs to ensure their sustainability. These initiatives reflect our commitment to inclusivity and accessibility for all patrons.
